Exemptions have had a major impact on tax districts' taxable values. With last year's increase in homestead exemption to \$50,000, the \$25,000 tangible personal property exemption, the ability to port (transfer) Amendment 10 benefits when changing homesteads, combined with the 10% cap on non-homestead property assessments effective this year, has put major strains on taxing authorities' revenue collecting abilities.
